Pre-season training at Lord's (the home of cricket) is coming along nicely with quite a few new people showing some interest in the club. Don't forget to check the website for all the training dates.

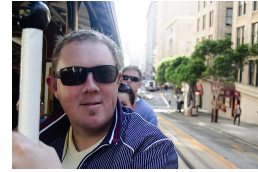
Social Calendar
